## MAHINDRA WORLD SCHOOL

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## **THE SCHOOL**

Mahindra World School, fondly referred by all as MWS, is a co-education school run by the Mahindra World School Educational Trust. Spread across a sprawling five-acre campus, Mahindra World School follows the CBSE syllabus and stresses not only on the academic development but also the overall development of the children. The school was established in the year 2008, to cater to the growing need of the Mahindra World City community for a quality educational institute. Mahindra World School currently has 1133 children and 70 Teaching Staff, 12 Office Staff, 5 Co-Scholastic Faculty, 12 Housekeeping Staff, 7 Landscape Staff, 12 Security (3 shifts) members on board with classes from Kindergarten to Grade XII. The school's infrastructure includes spacious classrooms equipped with modern teaching aids, English, Mathematics, Social, Language and Science Labs, well-equipped library, gymnasium, playground and a multi-purpose auditorium.

## **TRUSTEES VISIT**

On November 29, 2023, the respected trustees Ms. Sheetal Mehta, Mr. Ulhas Yargop and Mr. M.M. Murugappan of Mahindra World School visited the school, interacted with the students, teachers and staff members, and attended the Board Meeting later in the day.
